



Miniverde Versus TifEagle and Champion

1. Fast establishment without building thatch.
2. Deep rooting even when mowed below .125.
3. Moderate fertility requirement compared to Champion and Tif Eagle.
4. Cultural needs similar to Tifdwarf.
5. Very rhizometrous instead of surface spreading allowing excellent recovery from ball marks and spikes.
6. Continues to stay green and grow in cool temperatures of winter.
7. Better shade tolerance than Champion and TifEagle.
8. Better salt tolerance than Champion and TifEagle.
9. Better disease resistance and better tolerance of nematodes than Champion (due to deeper rooting).
10. Easier to topdress due to slightly lower density than Champion.
