

Miniverde Versus TifEagle and Champion

- 1. Fast establishment without building thatch.
- 2. Deep rooting even when mowed below .125.
- 3. Moderate fertility requirement compared to Champion and Tif Eagle.
- 4. Cultural needs similar to Tifdwarf.
- 5. Very rhyzometrous instead of surface spreading allowing excellent recovery from ball marks and spikes.
- 6. Continues to stay green and grow in cool temperatures of winter.
- 7. Better shade tolerance than Champion and TifEagle.
- 8. Better salt tolerance than Champion and TifEagle.
- 9. Better disease resistance and better tolerance of nematodes than Champion (due to deeper rooting).
- 10. Easier to topdress due to slightly lower density than Champion.
